Conditions of Entry

1. Conditions of Play

- i. The Pro-Am will be a 54-hole team stableford event with the best 2 scores from 4 to count, held over 3 courses Pinehurst No. 2, Pinehurst No. 4 and Pinehurst No. 8. (18 holes per day).
- ii. A maximum field of 25 teams will participate with the best 2 scores from 4 to count.
- iii. The handicap limit is 28 for men and 36 for ladies with the competition being played of a ¾ stroke allowance from the sloped handicap. All handicaps will be calculated using the USGA handicap slope system.
- iv. For the Professionals there will be an individual 54-hole stroke play event alongside the team stableford. Professionals will play alongside their amateurs for all 3 rounds.
- v. In the event of a tie for first place in the Professionals competition then the leading Professionals will share the combined prize money for the require number of places.
- vi. In the event of a tie in the Pro-Am Team competition then the winning team will be decided on a card playoff.
- vii. The event shall be played in accordance with The R&A Rules of Golf, PGAs of Europe Conditions of Competition and Local Rules and the Local Rules for each host golf course as determined by the Tournament Director.

2. Eligibility for Entry

The Pro-Am is open to all classified PGA Members, Trainees and Playing Professionals from any recognised PGA.

NB: All PGA Professionals' membership will be checked with the relevant PGA and any doubts to eligibility will be decided by the tournament committee whose decision will be final.

3. Championship Itinerary

25th February Hotel check in and registration, Practice round and Welcome Buffet Dinner
26th February First Tournament round on Pinehurst No. 4
27th February Second Tournament Round on Pinehurst No. 8
28th February Third Tournament Round on Pinehurst No. 2, Awards Presentation buffet and Departures. Tournament will finish by 1830hrs.





4. Withdrawals

Withdrawals for the event will be acted upon in accordance to section 7 of the PGAs of Europe Tournament Regulations.

Any Professional competitor who fails to record a score for any round or is disqualified, shall not be eligible for prize money.

Exceptions to these rules may be made in the case of sickness and other special circumstances subject always to the discretion of the appropriate Committee and to the provision of satisfactory evidence to the Association.
