Purpose	Description
Strictly	Cookies which are strictly necessary to provide services requested
Necessary	by the user
Performance	Cookies which collect information about how visitors use a website, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if
	they get error messages from web pages
Functionality	Cookies which allow a website to remember choices a user makes (such as user name, language or the region) and provide enhanced, more personal features



Targeting or	Cookies which are used to deliver adverts more relevant to a user

	times a user sees an advertisement as well as help measure the				
	effectiveness of the advertising campaign
